- Queen winner may be asked to make appearances throughout the remainder of the SeptemberFest activities, wearing her Tiara and Sash while in public. Queen winner will reign for a period of 1 year and must be available throughout the year for appearances.
- Queen winner must be available for all parades & activities in the city of Windsor, without prior notification.
- All winners must be available to hand down their title at the 2021 SeptemberFest Miss Windsor Queen contest.

- Judges decisions are final.

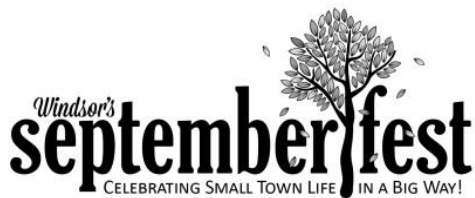

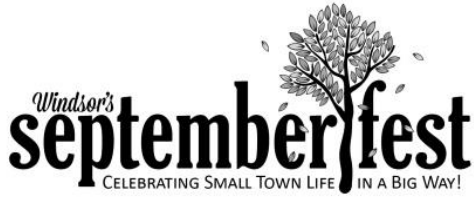
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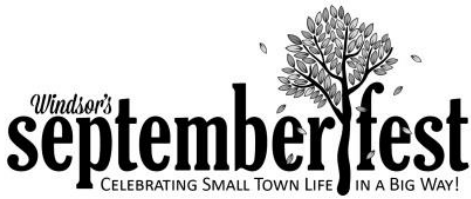
